Frequently Asked Questions

Prospective students often ask how long the **Bachelor of Arts in Health Informatics** takes to complete, what the program costs and if financial aid is available, and if the degree is awarded through USC Upstate.

You can find answers to these questions below.

- Completion time varies based on accumulated credits in general education and other courses required for the major. The degree requires 121-122 credit hours. It is up to the student and advisor to decide the appropriate number of hours to take each semester.

- The degree is awarded by the University of South Carolina Upstate and meets the same rigorous standards and accreditation as any traditional degree from UofSC.
