Students in the USC Upstate program work with real-world clients to produce publicity and informational materials, develop and implement public relations campaigns, and gain hands-on experience in this rapidly expanding field.

The curriculum includes coursework in the following topics:

- Communication Foundation 9 credit hours
- Public Relations Core 15 credit hours
- Media History and Theory 3 credit hours
- **Professional Options** 3 credit hours
- Media and Professional Option Electives 6 credit hours
- Research Methods and Capstone Project 6 credit hours
