The Online Bachelor of Arts in Political Science at USC Upstate offers opportunities to analyze the impact of political funding on legislation, understand elections and political campaigns, explore international relations and global politics, and so much more. This program prepares you for careers as attorneys, marketing professionals, managers, political analysts, intelligence analysts, city planners, non-profit organization directors, and teachers.

Internship and undergraduate research experiences and the optional online prelaw minor provide a strong foundation for law school or graduate study.

#### Curriculum

The curriculum includes coursework in the following topics:

- International and Comparative Politics 6 credit hours
- American Government or the Legislative Process 3 credit hours
- Internship, Study Abroad, or Service Learning 3 credit hours
- Research Methods and Senior Seminar 6 credit hours
- Other Political Science Courses 18 credit hours
