# Bridge to Faculty (B2F) Program

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- New program sponsored by the *President's Office* and administered through the *Office of Diversity, Equity and Inclusion*
- Goal is to **attract, support, and retain scholars from groups historically underrepresented in their fields**
- B2F Program will...
  - Recruit promising early-career scholars into **research-focused 2-year postdoctoral fellowships**
  - Provide high level of **mentoring and support** to launch career
  - Enable scholar to **transition to a tenure-track faculty position** after successful completion of the postdoc

# Psychology B2F Scholar

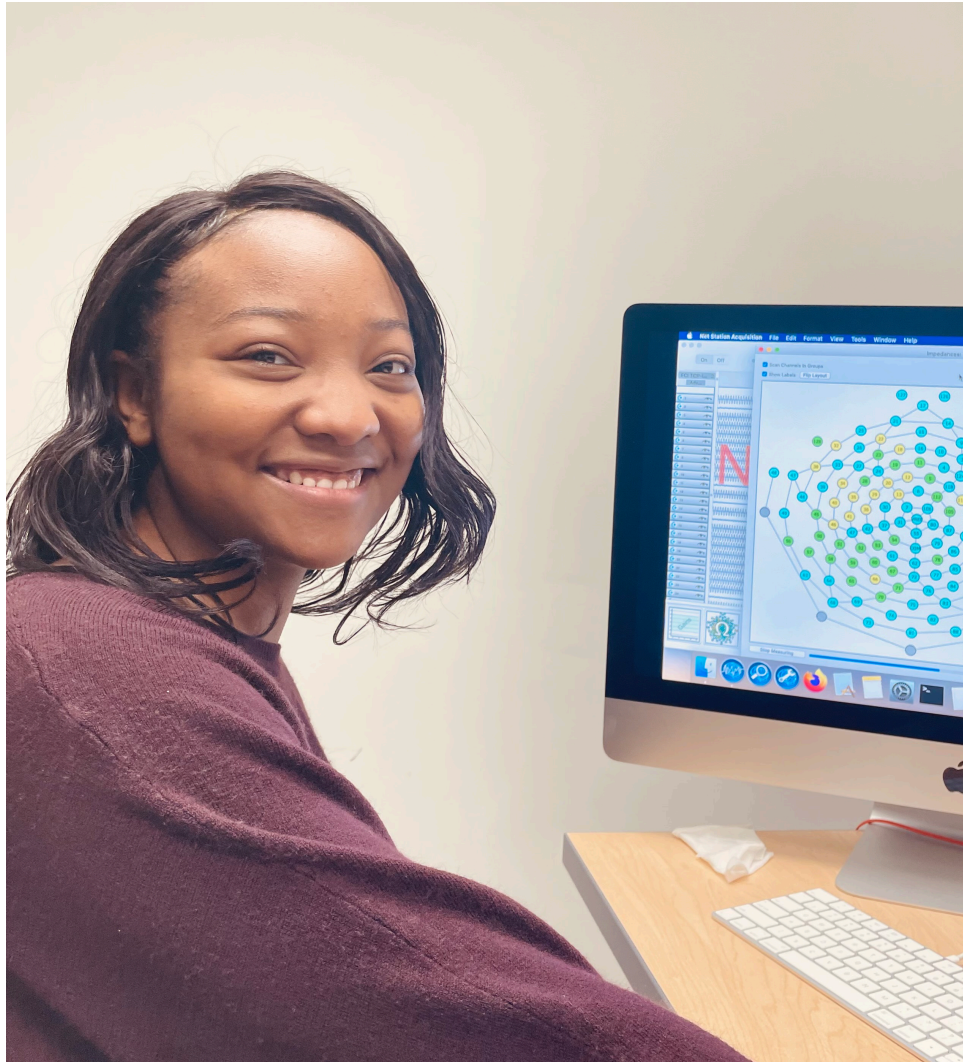

# Psychology B2F Scholar

## Is expected to:

1. Establish a robust program of research
2. Participate in the intellectual life of the department
3. Meet regularly with faculty mentors
4. Participate in professional development opportunities
5. Collaborate across the college and university, when appropriate





# Psychology B2F Scholar

- Will work with 1-2 primary research mentor(s) to accelerate transdisciplinary efforts in basic, clinical, or intervention research in neuroscience and/or health equity
- Should aspire to become an independent researcher and productive faculty member at an R1 university
- Must be committed to teaching and mentoring diverse students at the undergraduate and graduate level



# Psychology B2F Scholar

- A professional development mentorship team with experience mentoring underrepresented scholars will also support B2F scholar
- Additional university and peer mentorship will be available via University-wide B2F Cohort events

# Vento Lab on Aversive Learning

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Peter Vento, Ph.D.

- PhD in Behavioral Neuroscience from University of Buffalo
- Postdoctoral training at the Medical University of South Carolina
- Examines brain pathways that underlie learning from punishment and subsequent inhibition of behaviors. Deficits in these processes have severe consequences and are hallmark features of mental disorders including substance abuse and anxiety disorders

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Sayward Harrison, Ph.D.

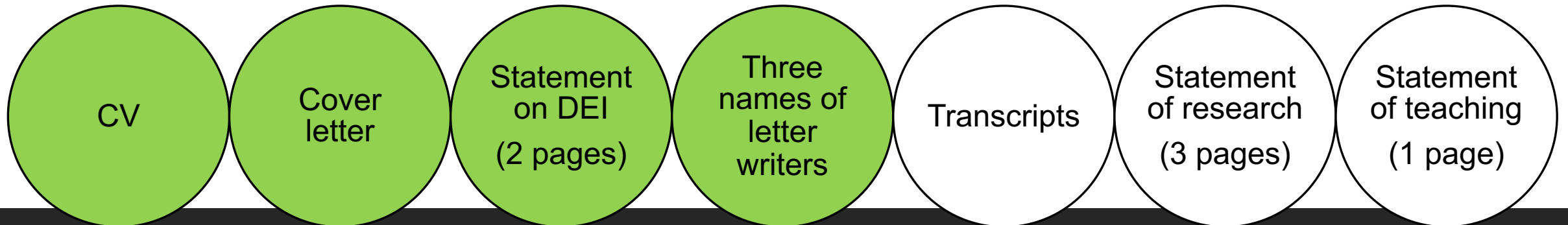
- PhD in Health Psychology from East Carolina University
