Tech2Teach Advisement Guide - BSPE in Physical Education

Students who have completed a minimum of 30 hours of college level credit can apply to UofSC Columbia as a transfer student. Students must meet the University of South Carolina transfer admissions requirements, which includes a 2.5 college GPA as calculated by UofSC at the time of application.

You are not required to take all courses listed prior to transferring and you are not required to take them in any particular order. Rather, this is a guide for you and your Technical College advisors to use when making course selection. Courses must be passed with a grade of C or higher in order to be considered for transfer credit.

*Students must meet the UofSC-College of Education Foreign Language requirement to finish the BS in Physical Education. Students can take the 101 and 102 levels of the same foreign language at the technical college to meet this requirement. Students who do not take 6 hours of the same Foreign Language at the technical college will take a Foreign Language placement test upon admission to UofSC and may exempt the Foreign Language requirement.
